Learn how to: use the AU Libraries catalog to find books; create and use hotmail, gmail and attach files; use Online Reference Chat, Ask-a-Librarian at Auburn; use Alabama Virtual Library databases to find magazines and newspapers; use the ‘Lexus-Nexis Academic’ databases at Auburn to find newspapers; use genealogy information; use and print online maps.
