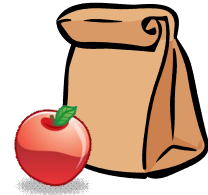


# SUMMER 2011 PROGRAMS

**Auburn University Library Orientation - A11301** (Claudine Jenda and Jean Liddell, instructors; Ralph Brown Draughon Library, 2nd Floor Lobby Computer Lab; Thursday, 4:30 - 6 p.m., June 2, 9, 16; space is limited). Learn how to: use the AU Libraries catalog to find books; use Online Reference Chat, Ask-a-Librarian at Auburn; use Alabama Virtual Library databases to find magazines and newspapers; and use the 'Lexis-Nexis Academic' databases at Auburn to find newspapers. After participating, you will better understand how the library is organized and what services are open to OLLI members.
